- 1 A term's notice is required before removing a pupil or changing a pupil's enrolment status.
- 2 A non-refundable administration fee of R 2 000 is payable on confirmation of enrolment.
- 3 Foreign-based learners are required to pay a terms fee as a refundable deposit on confirmation of enrolment.
- 4 A family rebate of 10% for the second child and 15% for the third and additional children is offered.
- 5 Fees are payable annually, termly or monthly.
  - 5.1 Annual and termly payments may be made by bank transfer, in cash deposited into the school's bank account, by cheque or credit card.
  - 5.2 Monthly payments must be paid by debit order and attract a charge of 5% per annum.
- 6 Interest will be levied at 2% per month on the total amount outstanding.
- 7 Discount is allowed in respect of the annual fees if paid on or before the first day of the first term.
- 8 Other expenses must be paid at the time the expense arises or as arranged with the Finance Department.
- 9 A fee of R200.00 will be levied for any extraordinary effort made to collect outstanding amounts.
