WORKBOOKS AND OTHER ESTIMATED COSTS PER GRADE

Grade 8 & Grade 9

Academics: Workbooks/Diary, Study skills, etc. will cost **approximately** R2500 for the year.

Outdoor Education: R700 for registering for the President's Award (Bronze)

Grade 10:

Academics: Textbooks/Workbooks/Diary etc. will cost R3 000 for the year excluding Visual Arts.

This figure may vary depending on the subjects your child has chosen.

Visual Arts: R1 500 – R2 000 (depending on the discipline the pupil chooses)

The Way: 21-day Journey

R1,700 per month Jan to Nov (11 months)

R17,500 if paid on or before 31 December 2025

Grade 11:

Academics: Workbooks/Diary etc. will cost **approximately** R3 000 for the year. This figure might vary depending on the subjects your child has chosen.

Visual Arts: R1 500 – R2 000 (depending on the discipline the pupil chooses)

Grade 12:

Textbooks/Workbooks/Diary etc. will cost **approximately** R3 000 for the year excluding Visual Arts but this figure might vary depending on the subjects your child has chosen.

Visual Arts: R1 500 – R2 000 (depending on the discipline the pupil chooses)

NSC Exams: R9 164 (8th subject is R1587)

Functions: R1 500
