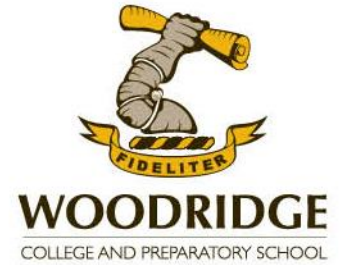

More than a school...an experience

The Woodridge Equestrian Centre caters for beginners, novice and experienced riders in the equestrian disciplines. WEC offers excellent Equestrian facilities which include flatwork, lunge and jumping arenas, and lots of space for secure out-rides with a large Cross-country course.

TUITION (on a School or privately-owned horse)

GROUP TUITION: 1 x lesson per week R205 per
lesson (3-4 riders) 2 x lessons per week R360 for 2
lessons

RIDING GEAR: According to SAEA. For safety reasons, riders must ride in the correct headgear (a riding helmet with a chin strap joining at 3 points or a skull cap). Riding shoes with a small heel are also compulsory. Riding helmets are available to borrow from the WEC, but it is advisable to obtain your own modern helmet with improved shock absorption. Riders may not groom, turnout or lead horses without the correct helmet and shoes on.

THE ROSTER TIMES: Current riding times for parents: Wednesdays and Fridays mornings.
Pupils: Mon-Friday afternoons or Saturday mornings.

STABLING (LIVERY): The horses are fed a balanced diet and go out every day into large electronically fenced paddocks with grazing, water and shade. Horses are groomed and cared for by experienced grooms. The stables are large with shavings for bedding. Horses are shod every 5-6 weeks if necessary. Farrier and veterinary bills are not included in the livery fees and will be billed to your Woodridge Account. Any additional supplements, poultices, creams and or veterinary ointments etc are to be purchased by the owner for the horse and clearly labelled. IL Fly spray included in livery costs.

Stabled horses: R4 598 per month

Live-out horses: R3 338 per month

Please note: One month's livery is payable before the end of the previous term to secure a stable. We reserve the right to increase the livery charges should actual costs exceed anticipated costs.
