1 Pre-admission amounts payable for new pupils:

- 1.1 A **non-refundable** administration fee of R 2 000 that will be forfeited in the event of cancelling the registration.
- 1.2 For all new registrations for **2020**, an **enrolment payment** equal to one term's fees (tuition fees OR tuition and boarding) is payable.
- 1.3 Two thirds of the enrolment payment are refundable 3 months after the scholar leaves Woodridge, free of interest and not to be offset against fees due. No interest will accrue or be payable on the refundable portion.
- 1.4 In the case of early termination (i.e. before the scholar completes his/her schooling), the **refundable portion** will be held until the scholar leaves Woodridge and all acceptable charges on their account have been recorded and settled.
- 1.5 One third of the enrolment payment is a **non-refundable facilities development levy**. Woodridge shall be entitled to utilise the levy for operational requirements at the sole discretion of Woodridge.
- 1.6 In the case of new entrants in Grade 11 and 12, these amounts will be pro-rated.
- 1.7 At the commencement of Grade 4 and Grade 8, a **top-up deposit** will be payable to meet the current grade's termly fees, one third of which will be a **non-refundable facilities development levy** and the balance added to the refundable portion. No interest will accrue on the refundable portion.
- 1.8 In the case of siblings being enrolled, a sibling rebate of 10% for the second child and 15% for the third and additional children will apply to the enrolment payment.

2 Conversion from day scholar to boarding:

- 2.1 It will be required to top-up up the term's deposit for a conversion from day scholar to boarding.
- 2.2 A boarder converting to day scholar would be immediately eligible for a partial refund.

3 Notice period on termination of contract:

A term's notice is required before removing a scholar or changing a scholar's enrolment status. If the required notice is not given, a term's fees in lieu of notice will be payable and charged to the scholar's account.

4 Sibling discounts:

In terms of tuition only or tuition and boarding fees, a sibling rebate of 10% for the second child and 15% for the third and additional children is offered.

5 Fees and other costs/expenses:

Fees are payable annually, termly or, for South African Residents only, monthly.

- 5.1 Payments may be made by debit order, bank transfer, credit/debit card, or, if in cash, deposited directly into the school's bank account at a Standard Bank branch. Bank charges incurred by cash or foreign payments will be transferred to the payer's account.
- 5.2 Monthly payments available to South African residents (over 10 months from January, or 8 months from January for Grade 12) attract a charge of 5% per annum, included in the monthly rates above.
- 5.3 Other expenses must be paid at the time the expense arises or as arranged with the Finance Department.
- 5.4 As an option, pocket money of R50 per week will be issued to boarders by their house-parents and will be charged back to the person responsible for the account.
- 5.5 Fees for Grade 000 to Grade 0 include Monkeynastix and Kindermusik fees.

6 Interest payable on overdue accounts:

Interest will be levied at 2% per month on the total of any arrears each month. Additional collection fees will be levied for any extraordinary effort made to collect outstanding amounts as per our Debtors Policy.

7 Scholar Accident Insurance:

A compulsory Scholar Accident Insurance and Emergency Rescue fee is payable at the beginning of the year.

8 Medical Aid cover for foreign scholars:

It is compulsory for foreign students to have medical cover for the full academic year. Where a scholar does not have own arranged medical aid, the School will arrange such medical cover and the cost will be charged to the scholar account. Terms and conditions will apply, and the School cannot guarantee that the cover obtained is comprehensive or will cover all medical expenses incurred.
